DESCRIPTION

Marechiaro Four-Seater Sofa by **Mario Marengo** for **Arflex**.

Designed by the Italian architect Mario Marengo in 1976, the Marechiaro sofa remains relevant today due to its formal essentiality. Embodying an elongated boxy shape, this spacious four-seat sofa caters to large groups and families. Its simple design renders it a timeless piece of furniture, suitable for residential and commercial spaces.

The Marechiaro collection comprises three and four-seater versions of the sofa, as well as a modular sofa system. These can be found in the 'related product' section below.

The Marechiaro Four Seater Sofa is made from two 90cm width units without armrests (2912) and two 114cm width units with one armrest (2906).

MATERIALS

Structure composed of metal, poplar plywood and birch plywood. Backrest and armrests with elastic straps. Cushion shaped polyurethane with differentiated density / polyester slip cover. Feet in black lacquered metal with nylon glides.
