DESCRIPTION

Wooden chair by Marc Newson for Cappellini.

From a desire to push the boundaries of manipulation with wood, the Australian designer Marc Newson developed the Wooden Chair in 1992, a sculptural piece of furniture that offers surprising comfort.

His daring experiments with the natural material led him to develop a fluid and continuous form made from steambent beech wood strips. The seat has a 'double curve' or 'alpha' shape, whilst the backrest extends down, around and back. The horizontal bracing at each end provides strength and support, making the seat robust and longlasting.

With its organic form, made from oiled natural solid beech wood, the seat invites a warm presence to its space.
