DESCRIPTION

Safari chair by **Kaare Klint** for **Carl Hansen + Son**.

Kaare Klint designed the Safari chair in 1933 and was inspired by chairs he had seen an American cinematographer and his wife use on an African safari. He wanted to transform the portable, knockdown version into an elegant chair for modern interiors.

The Safari chair is a sophisticated and lightweight chair that clearly demonstrates Kaare Klint's sense of proportions, fine craftsmanship and remarkable material combinations.

The frame is made from solid wood, available in ash (white oiled) or smoked stained ash (oiled). Seat and back cushion in canvas or leather in Thor: 301, 307, 325 or 332. Armrests in natural saddle leather.
