Charlotte Perriand's 7 Fauteuil Tournant chair, a design icon boasting versatility and functionality, was created in 1927 for her Parisian flat at Place Saint-Sulpice. Initially presented at the 1928 Salon des Artistes Décorateurs, followed by the 1929 Salon d'Automne, this chair's flexible design allowed it to serve as a dining, side, or executive chair with equal ease.

The design has now been adapted for outdoor use, with a special textured powder-coat finish applied to the stainless steel frame to make it weather-resistant. Additionally, the upholstery has been specially treated for outdoor use without sacrificing its beauty and comfort. This allows the design to be used in various outdoor settings while maintaining its iconic style and functionality.
