Norman Cherner was an American designer notable for his pioneering work on prefabricated housing as well as his furniture designs. His moulded plywood chair displays considerable technical expertise and reflects the preoccupation with this material of his contemporaries Charles and Ray Eames.

Designed in 1958 and now reissued in exacting detail from the original drawings and moulds, the Cherner chair combines the best of both moulded plywood and solid bent wood construction.
