DESCRIPTION

Plate 184 Rug by **Gunta Stölzl** for **Christopher Farr**.

Gunta Stölzl, a textile artist and the only female master of the Bauhaus is widely regarded as the most influential figure in the modern history of Western woven art. During her time at the school, she brought great success to the facility with her radical ideas and experimentation with methods and materials.

One of her works, created on paper in the 1920s, is now produced by Christopher Farr as a limited edition Plate 184 rug. Composed of linear forms in contrasting hues of blue, orange and red, this eye-catching rug adds texture and depth to a space.

The Stölzl Estate has been closely involved in the process, ensuring the result is as faithful to the original work as possible.
