DESCRIPTION

3131 Grand Prix Swivel Chair by **Arne Jacobsen** for **Fritz Hansen**.

Arne Jacobsen's Grand Prix chair earned its name from the 1957 Triennale in Milan, where it was honoured with the highest accolade of the exhibition. The iconic seat shell is meticulously crafted through the steam-bending process, forming a single piece composed of nine layers of veneer.

The 3131 swivel chair, with height adjustability, features an elevated five-legged steel base complemented by aluminium-capped castors with a twin-wheeled design to enhance movement.
