3139 Grand Prix Bar Stool by Arne Jacobsen for Fritz Hansen.

The Grand Prix by Arne Jacobsen was named after the prestigious award it was awarded at the 1957 Triennale in Milan. This iconic chair is made by meticulously bending and layering nine veneer pieces, creating a single, seamless shell.

The 3139 barstool maintains the same seat design as the original seat but distinguishes itself with elongated legs and a tubular steel footrest. This heightened design enhances the visual continuity of the seat's streamlined aesthetic.
