DESCRIPTION

HM26 arm stool designed by **Frederick Scott** for **Hitch Mylius**.

HM26 is a family of generously proportioned sofas. The HM26 collection of sofas was designed as a tribute to Frederick Scott, one of Britain's most renowned furniture designers. Scott initially designed the successful HM25 range of seating for Hitch Mylius. After Scott's death, and in collaboration with Scott's daughter Georgia, Hitch Mylius expanded the range with the addition of HM26 in 2002. The HM26 is a more relaxed and informal version of Scott's classic HM25.

The MH26 range consists of an armchair, a two-seat and three-seat sofa, see in the 'Product range' below.
