Hogla Storage Basket by **Maison Bengal**.

Maison Bengal is a social enterprise that works with marginalised communities in Bangladesh to provide local women with a dependable source of income. Using traditional hand-weaving techniques and locally sourced materials, Maison Bengal supports community workshops in producing a range of woven goods for house and home.

This family of sturdy and practical baskets are woven from the dried leaves and stems of the Hogla plant - also known as seagrass. These durable natural fibres are traditionally used to weave sleeping and prayer mats and to reinforce the walls of huts, as well as being used to make a variety of baskets and containers.

The round base of these baskets allows them to be used as freestanding storage containers for laundry, toys or household items.

Available in three sizes, from extra small to large, which nest inside each other for ease of storage.

Handmade in Bangladesh using natural materials.
