Elizabeth Lounge Chair by Ib Kofod-Larsen for Audo Copenhagen.

Designed by Ib Kofod-Larsen in 1956, the Elizabeth lounge chair is considered by many to be the Danish designer's most iconic design. Skillfully crafted using traditional craftsman techniques, the sculptural frame and low sleigh-like seat offer timeless design and exceptional comfort to its setting.

Originally named the U-56, the chair was later renamed the Elizabeth after Queen Elizabeth II purchased a pair on a visit to Copenhagen in the early 1960s. The seat is a prime example of Modern Danish furniture and stands up to its name, delivering a refined royal elegance.
