DESCRIPTION

Panthella 320 table light by Verner Panton for Louis Poulsen.

Verner Panton first created the Panthella in 1971 and has become one of his most iconic pieces. The light is defined by an organic, hemispherical shade and a trumpet stem.

The Panthella 320 table light emits a glare-free and soft illumination, the metal shades direct the light vertically downwards whereas the opal acrylic shade diffuses the light 360° thanks to the translucent shade.

The Panthella is a timeless design that can fit into any interior style, perfect for a coffee table or sideboard in the modern home.

MATERIALS

White opal acrylic, Grey opal acrylic with chrome base, High lustre chrome or Brass metallised.

Shade: Injection moulded white opal acrylic or deep drawn steel.

Base and Housing: Cast aluminium.

Diffuser: Injection moulded opal pmma.

Cable type: Plastic cord with plug. Cable length: 2.5m.

White cord on white opal and metalized brass versions. Black cord on gray opal and chrome versions.

Light control: On/off switch on cord. Diffuser with bajonet lock.

Light source: 1 x 7.5W E14
