## DESCRIPTION

**Pie de Salon floor lamp** by **Jaume Sans** for **Santa + Cole**.

Classic floor lamp from Santa + Cole. Jaume Sans was a renowned Catalan surrealist sculptor and painter. He was also a member of the artistic association ADLAN that included amongst its members Picasso, Dalí, Miró and Calder, all acquaintances of the GATCPAC architects with whom they shared their social venue on Passeig de Gràcia in pre-Spanish Civil War Barcelona.

Sans focused on the design of furniture for his own household, which is how the remarkable Pie de Salón or Peana Molina lamps were created, and later edited by Santa & Cole. A sleek reinterpretation of traditional symmetrical lamps, with a chrome shaft. The stem of the lamp is adjustable and is leather-covered for a luxurious feel, opening up into a tripod base that allows the cable to easily go through.

A perfect example of industrial craftsmanship. It features three distinct shades in three different materials and eight colour options that exude timeless elegance.

## MATERIALS

The adjustable leather-covered brass shaft opens out into a base with three points of support.

Shades are available in three different shapes and in either stitched beige cardboard, natural ribbon or white linen.  
G1 and G3 are also available in terracotta, mustard, or green raw coloured ribbon.

Height adjustable chrome-plated or polished brass structure.  
Shaft covered in black leather.
