I-S k Poster by Josef Albers for The Wrong Shop.

This 1973 I-S k design is from Josef Albers' 'Homage to the Square' series, which explores colour interaction and is considered his most significant work. The mathematically arranged concentric squares, in various hues, comprise over two thousand works and remain a key influence in colour theory and art education.

Albers (1888-1976) studied and taught at the Bauhaus for over a decade. His ground-breaking book, 'Interaction of Color,' is as relevant today as it was when first published in 1963.

This high-quality print is created closely with the Josef & Anni Albers Foundation. Available unframed or with the addition of a self-assembly, sleek aluminium frame.
