Flemming Lassen designed The Tired Man in 1936. The highly organic form and grand scale was extremely progressive for its time. Flemming Lassen worked with Arne Jacobsen and was a leading exponent of Functionalism in Denmark.

The Tired Man chair was re-launched in 2015 at the Stockholm Furniture Fair and reflects an important landmark early modernist seating. A matching footstool is also available; please **enquire** for details.
