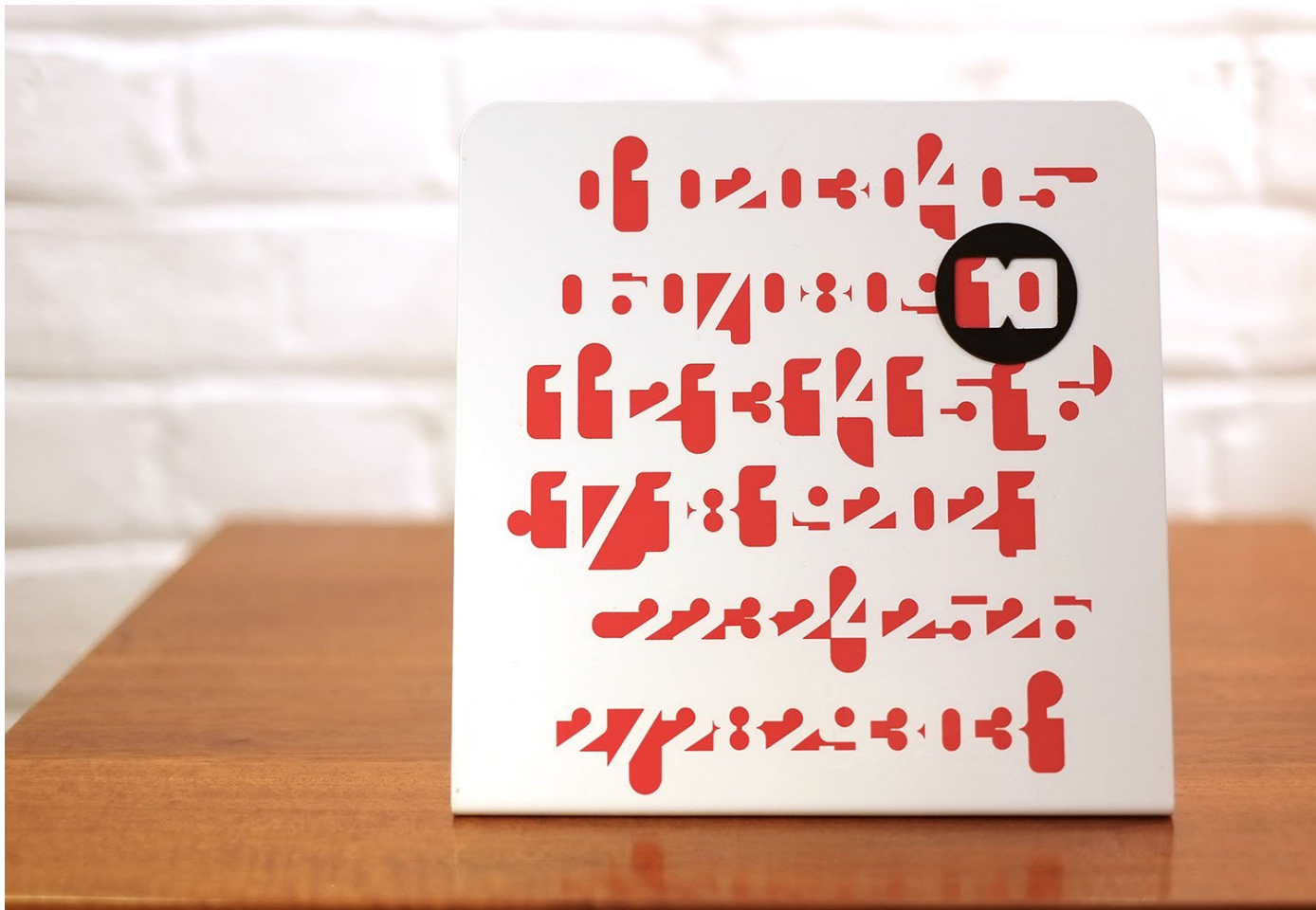

## DESCRIPTION

**Imbroglia desk calendar** by **Jean-Pierre Vitrac** for **twentytwentyone**.

The freestanding version of the famous perpetual calendar designed by one of the great French industrial designers Jean Pierre Vitrac.

The panel is made from powder-coated steel with screen-printed graphic and plastic, magnetic cursor. The plastic cursor frames define the numbers 1 - 31 giving a calendar function.

The word Imbroglia means hidden or muddled in France, where the design originates.
