DESCRIPTION

Eames DCM chair by Charles + Ray Eames for Vitra.

Designed by Charles and Ray Eames in 1945, DCM stands for Dining Chair Metal. The Eames often varied their chair designs by combining one seat shell with different bases. Accordingly, from the very outset, Plywood Group was optionally available with a chromed tubular steel frame which lent the design a greater sense of lightness and created an exciting tension between its two contrasting materials.
