

DESCRIPTION

Eames Hang It All by Charles & Ray Eames for Vitra.

The Eames Hang it All has become one of the most immediately recognisable and well-loved design icons of the twentieth century.

Used instead of simple hooks, these brightly-coloured wooden spheres were aimed at encouraging children to hang up "all their things". Because the distance between the spheres always remains the same, Hang it All can be extended as required and is a cheerful alternative to standard clothes-hooks, not only for children's rooms.
