EM Table HPL by Jean Prouvé for Vitra.

At the beginning of the 1950s, Jean Prouvé developed the EM Table for the 'Maison-Tropique' project. It illustrates the force path and the static connections in a way that is otherwise only featured in engineering constructions.

The EM Table can be ideally combined with Prouvé's Standard chairs, but also with various other chairs.
